You may revoke your authorization at any time, subject to providing notice of seven (7) days. Notice shall be in writing or by telephone. To obtain a sample cancellation form, or for more information on your right to cancel a PAD Agreement, contact your financial institution or visit www.cdnpay.ca.

This PAD agreement only applies to the method of payment between you and the Utility and this PAD Agreement and any termination of this PAD agreement does not have any effect whatsoever with respect to any contract for service between you and the Utility.

You have certain recourse rights if any debit does not comply with this agreement. For example, you have the right to receive reimbursement for any debit that is not authorized or is not consistent with this PAD Agreement.
